CONFERENCES

We offer a variety of housing and meeting accommodations to best serve the needs of your group. With at least 300 beds covering more than 400 acres and meeting rooms for groups of all sizes, we are sure to have the facilities to accommodate you during our non-summer camp season.

MEETING SPACES

We also offer many amazing outdoor meeting spaces such as our chapel, campfire, rec hall, and airnasium. Here is a brief breakdown of indoor spaces, which have heating/air conditioning and bathrooms.

MEALS

Our Dining Hall has wonderful meals prepared fresh for every group. Meals can be served family style or buffet. The dining hall has coffee/tea available all day (and night), and during breakfast we have alternative options with a cereal, bagel, and fruit and yogurt bar. At lunch and dinner we have a full salad bar and sandwich station. At YMCA Camp Hanes we work hard to meet our guest needs. Some common food allergies and dietary restrictions can be accommodated by our dining hall, please just let us know. We are a peanut and tree nut aware facility.

An example of a daily meal could be:

Breakfast: bacon, eggs, biscuits and grits with fruit choice and water.

Lunch: mini corn dogs with macaroni and cheese with water.

Dinner: spaghetti with meat sauce, corn, and garlic bread with tea and water.

LODGING

All the cabins have heating/air conditioning, running water, screen doors and windows. They also have attached bathroom facilities with at least 2 showers, 2 toilets, and 2 sinks.
